Today, Tamarack Foods celebrated the completion of planning and construction of a new building and renovation of an older one with a Ribbon Cutting ceremony, immediately followed by an Open House.

Guests included other manufacturing neighbors, customers, employees, government officials, and suppliers of Tamarack Foods through a "Celebration of Friends!"

Tamarack Foods will manufacture frozen tempura chicken from its Americus facility at 119 Old Andersonville Road, Americus, GA, 31719; samples were cooked for the event.

The opening ceremony began with a grateful and warm welcome from Tamarack president Tim Andersen, followed by an introduction of his "teammates."

The company began as B and D Foods making tempura fried chicken but has evolved into other successful partnerships over the years with brand industries such as P F Chang and InnovAsian—through Walmart and Aldi channels.

Tim has been in the food industry *for over 30 years, with extensive experience in the frozen food business.* "The Idaho plant was filled, and we began looking throughout the U.S. for

another facility," said Anderson. The Southeast, location to suppliers, perfect building, and the community met Tamarack's criteria.
