



Powering the Future: NanoPV Solar Expands Footprint with Bold New Acquisitions!

NanoPV Solar purchased two more buildings in 2025, building on its 2024 acquisitions of the speculative building and 29 additional acres. The first building is in the Ted Baldwin Industrial Park, where the company bought a former call center on Industrial Drive. The second was on Tripp Street, the site of the former Manhattan Shirt Company.
